It is our pleasure to announce that, effective May 9, 2000, responsibility for a number of functions previously performed by Headquarters MTMC has been transferred to MTMC Deployment Support Command (DSC). These functions include:

- Negotiations for Movement of Bulk Petroleum Products by Pipeline (non-GT)
- ATCMD Effectiveness Program
- MTMC Freight Rules Publications (Except 1B and 50)

MTMC Freight Traffic Rules Publications: Responsibility for most, but not all, MTMC Freight Rules Publications will be handled by DSC's Freight Routing Division, Mr. Stephen Lord, Chief. The following three publications are transferred effective May 9, 2000:

- MTMC Freight Traffic Rules Publication (MFTRP) 10 (Rail)
- MFTRP 4A (Bulk Commodities via Tank Truck Service)
- MTMC Pipeline Rules Publication 6A.

The MFTRP 1A (Motor) will remain the responsibility of Headquarters MTMC until its upcoming replacement by the MFTRP 1B. A Federal Register announcement implementing the 1B is expected to be published in June. The actual effective date will be announced therein, and will also constitute the date that the 1B will become the responsibility of MTMC DSC. Responsibility for the MTMC Guaranteed Traffic Rules Publication (MGTRP 50) will remain within the Joint Traffic Management Office at Headquarters MTMC and will not be transferred to DSC.
